BSB41419 Certificate IV in Work Health and Safety

This qualification is suitable for people working in a Work Health and Safety (WHS) role who work to provide leadership and guidance to others and have some limited responsibility for the output of others.

The qualification reflects the role of workers who apply a broad knowledge base and well developed skills in a wide variety of contexts and may include coordinators, advisors and facilitators.

COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no entry requirements for this qualification however Illawarra ITeC require students to have average english, reading and writing skills, or higher and should have completed Year 10 or above schooling, or have sound workplace written communication skills. Participants will be required to complete a Language, Literacy & Numeracy (LLN) Assessment prior to enrolment.

UNITS OF STUDY

To be awarded a full qualification in Certificate IV in Work Health and Safety - BSB41415 you will need to be assessed as competent in 5 core plus 5 elective units of competency (10 units of competency). A Statement of Attainment will be issued for units deemed competent if a full qualification is not achieved.
